December 9, 2015

Attendance:

Chairman Gary Derr, Vice-Chairman Walt Rupert, Supervisor/Secretary Judy Achy, Zoning Officer, Mike Kull & Solicitor Attorney Robert Buehner. Public was represented by John Fenstermacher, David Fox, & Danville News Reporter, Karen Blackledge.

Call to Order:

Chairman Gary Derr called the meeting to order @ 7:00 p.m. with all in attendance reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes:

Citizens' Comments: John Fenstermacher came to the supervisors with a problem with feral cats in his neighborhood where he indicated one neighbor counted 20 cats in the Eister Loop area. He indicated one of the neighbors is feeding the cats so he indicated "it's like a parade to the door of the person feeding them". Walt Rupert reported that he knew of the same issue in Scott Township and he will contact their officials for guidance. John indicated he works diligently trying to keep his property in great shape and the cats are filthy and defecating all over his property.
