

VALLEY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS' MINUTES

January 2, 2018

Attendance:

Chairman Gary Derr, Vice-Chairman Walt Rupert, Supervisor Mike Kull, & Secretary, Judy Achy. Public was represented by Joe Harvey.

Call to Order:

Chairman Gary Derr called the meeting to order @ 7:20 p.m. with all in attendance reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes:

Motion to approve the minutes of December 13, 2017 as well as the financial statement made by Walt, 2nd by Mike and motion approved unanimously.

Citizens' Comments: Joe Harvey of Key Trucking came to the Supervisors to request an additional 60' by '64 (3,840 square foot) garage addition to the previously proposed 14,640 square foot garage. This request was reviewed by the township engineer, HRG, and they indicated that the building changes appear to be consistent with the township ordinance and previously approved stormwater management report and design. ***Motion to grant tentative approval by Mike, 2nd by Gary pending Planning Commission approval and motion approved unanimously.*** Due to the Supervisors needing to meet on January 2 due to the law, the Planning Commission meeting will follow tomorrow evening at 7:00 p.m.

Fire Department – Chief Mike Kull reported that there were a total of 19 incidents in December including 11 vehicle accidents, 3 gas leaks, 1 structure fire (Derry Twp), 2 EMS assists and 2 public service calls.

Municipal Authority – Walt reported that the bridge at the Continental Fire Department is no longer going to be replaced and will now be refurbished so there is no need for the Municipal Authority to be concerned about moving their lines.

Road Foreman/Equipment Report – Gary Derr reported that the Dodge was out for inspection and has a need for new U bolts as well as the front loaders need to be replaced and this will be taken care of by the Valley Township Road Crew. There were two new tires placed on the T-tag. The township has been busy with snow removal and clearing out the township maintenance building.
